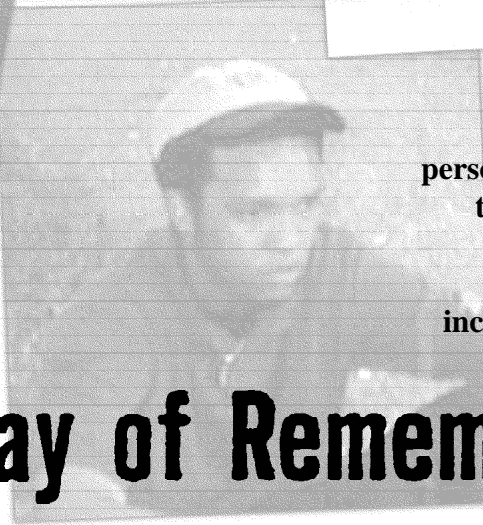


People Are
